

The ThumbPopUp action.

The ThumbPopUp action enables you to display larger versions of images in perfectly sized popup windows, without having to create a html page for each and every one of them.

This action also eliminates the common problem with built-in browser margins when displaying images in popup windows.

Other features are:

- X and Y position of the popup window.
- Chrome options like, menu bar, scroll bars, directories, etc.
- Popup window title.
- Background color.

This is how you use the action:

1. Make a text or image link (this will probably be the thumbnail image).
2. In the link URL field enter either a # sign or javascript:void(0).
3. In the action inspector select an event (you will probably use the "Mouse click" event).
4. Click the "action" button and select the ThumbPopUp action.
5. Set the options starting with the link to the larger image, then the size, chrome, position, title and background color.
